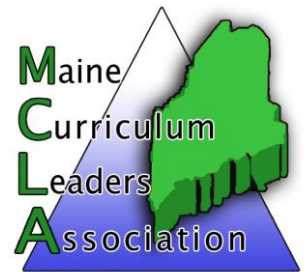


The Maine Curriculum Leaders' Association
